Program Purpose

This program is designed to cultivate a deep, personal connection with the Qur'an while strengthening knowledge of Islamic sciences. Through study, reflection, and service, students grow into compassionate ambassadors of faith who live and share the message of Islam with sincerity and purpose.

Subjects Covered

1. Word-by-Word Quranic Analysis

Understand each ayah through its root meanings, grammar, and structure, building a lasting connection with the Quranic language.

2. Tafseer with Practical Reflection

Gain insight into the context and application of verses for personal and societal reform.

3. Word Meaning Tests

A test will be uploaded after every half Juz to reinforce vocabulary. Students must print, complete, and email their responses as instructed.

4. Tajweed

A structured course to help students apply proper pronunciation, articulation, and Tajweed rules while reciting the Quran. **Tajweed review session will be conducted alongside your weekly Tafseer review.**

5. Hadith Studies

Students will study authentic narrations from **Lulu wal Jaan**, accompanied by detailed explanations and practical lessons relevant to everyday life. To ensure comprehension, regular quizzes will be conducted to assess understanding and reinforce learning.

6. Hifz Requirements

All students are required to memorize **Juz 30**. If you have already memorized Juz 30, then proceed to memorize **Surah Al-Mulk, Surah Al-Kahf, and Surah As-Sajdah**.

7. Arabic Grammar (optional)

Students will study essential grammar rules that enable them to understand the Quran in its original Arabic form and become independent learners.

8. Dawah Participation

- Students are required to organize or participate in at least **four dawah booths** annually to promote Islamic awareness. They are responsible for maintaining a log or keeping a record of their dawah activities to meet the course requirements.
- If a student is not able to participate physically (case-by-case review), she must join the calling team and make weekly dawah calls.

*Training will be provided to all calling team and dawah volunteers.

9. Review Sessions

All students are required to participate in weekly review sessions led by the senior student serving as the group monitor. These sessions will cover a review of your weekly Tafseer and Tajweed lessons.

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
