# **ArRahmah Tafseer 2025 - Official Courses Policy**

## 1. Admission Policy

- Admission to the Tafseer Program will close after the completion of Juz 5.
- Individuals enrolling after Juz 5 will be consider student but no eligibility for graduation in the current academic cycle.

# 2. Requirements for Students Joining Before Juz 5

Students admitted during Juz 1–4 are required to:

- 1. Review all previously delivered lectures pertaining to the missed juz portions.
- 2. Complete all pending juz assignments corresponding to the missed content.
- 3. Attempt and pass all required test assigned within the initial five juz.

## 3. Attendance Requirement (Review Sessions)

- Review Session Attendance shall serve as the sole official attendance metric and the primary criterion for academic evaluation.

#### 4. Low Attendance Protocol

- Students whose Review Session Attendance falls **below 50%** must submit the complete juz test for that portion.
- Exemptions will not be granted for reasons such as vacation, prolonged interruptions, inconsistent participation, or similar circumstances.

#### **5. Two-Month Consecutive Absence Policy**

If a student remains absent for **two consecutive months** without prior notification to the Group Monitor:

- The student's name will be removed from the active enrollment list.

- Upon return, the student will be reinstated as a new enrollee, requiring the repetition of all missed lectures, assignments, and assessments.

### **6. Excused Absence Policy**

- Genuine medical or familial emergencies may qualify for an excused absence.
- Upon return, the student must fulfill all missed academic requirements, including lectures, assignments, and assessments.

## 7. One-Year Assessment Gap

If a student does not attempt any test for a full period of one year:

- Their status will be terminated from the regular student sheet.
- The individual will be moved to the Listener Group, and no academic record will be maintained for them.

# 8. Voluntary Listener Classification

Students who declare at the outset that they do not wish to attempt assessments or graduate will:

- Be formally categorized as Listeners.
- Have no attendance or academic progress tracked by the institute.

## 9. Eligibility for Graduation

Graduation shall be awarded exclusively to students who:

- Joined the program on or before Juz 5
- Maintain consistent attendance in Review Sessions
- Complete all required assignments
- Attempt and successfully complete all course requirements
- Demonstrate compliance with all institutional rules and academic standards
- All subjects and course requirements must be successfully completed as a mandatory condition for course completion.
